

**THE CENTER FOR FOOD ACTION DISTRIBUTED
53,142 EMERGENCY FOOD PACKAGES IN 2010**

- An emergency food package consists of seven days worth of food; the amount of food a household receives is based on family size. On average, an emergency food package consists of 10 bags of groceries.
- CFA provided Thanksgiving food packages to 4,519 households - 10,577 people.
- CFA increased the number of times clients can come for help from 6 times a year to 12 times a year.
- CFA helped 1,517 households with other basic needs: Rent -299 Households, Security Deposits - 282 Households, Utility & Heating Bills - 929 Households, Miscellaneous Assistance - 7.
